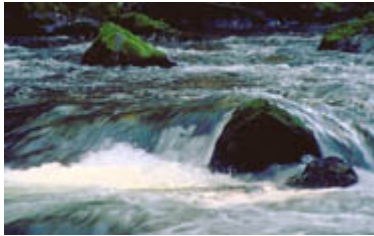

Locate and Read your Water Meter

Locate Your Meter

Water meters are typically located:



- In iron boxes sunk in the ground;
- In the parking strip or sidewalk in front of or at the side of your house;
- Covered by a 1x2 ft. metal plate that says CWM (City Water Meter).

If you cannot locate your water meter please call (206) 684-5800.

Read Your Meter

- Using a small rod, crow bar or screwdriver to lift the lid off the cover.
- Write down the last three (3) numbers printed on the meter cap.
- Lift the cap and write down the 4 black and 2 red numbers on the meter from left to right just as you would a car/ mileage odometer. (see image to the right)
- Lower the cap, and securely replace the metal cover.
